**Principal's Report:**

- Teachers have started their Department Days where they are working on their curriculum maps, midterm/final exams, EDGE challenges, and goals for the year.
- Our district cohorts (Personalized Learning/Community Engagement, Leadership, and Culture/Wellness) have started and are working on both professional learning and goals for the year.
- The public release for our Kentucky Summative Assessment (KSA) data is October 18th.
- Tutoring is going strong 3 days per week and has been a huge help to students. This is paid for through ESS funds. Any student who is failing a class for 3 weeks or more is automatically placed in required tutoring.
- We have cut down on faculty work session time to give time for teachers to meet in grade level teams (who teach the same group of students).
- Niche results were shared and Beechwood Independent School District is 2nd in the state.
- Purdue, a partner for our SEAD lab, came to work with 2 of our teachers on experiential learning and AgriScience professional development. They also our helping develop curriculum and providing summer workshops for students at Purdue.
- With our new PA system, we have microphones in our classroom for teachers and/or students to use and they have a safety feature to call an emergency.
- This week we have planning period PLC meetings with teachers to go over housekeeping, assessment information, and some professional learning take-aways to try in the classroom.
