Thank you for your interest in the Beechwood Schools' tuition student program. Beechwood Independent School District is a unique K-12, one building, public school district located in Ft. Mitchell, Kentucky. The elementary school and the high school each have enrollments of over 700 students. Throughout their history, the Beechwood Schools have been noted for their sense of tradition and academic excellence.

Both Beechwood Elementary School and Beechwood High School have received numerous awards and honors for their outstanding accomplishments. The exemplary level of performance exhibited by Beechwood students over the years has been directly related to the high expectations set by the schools for achievement and the consistently strong level of parental involvement and support. As a result, the tuition admission process is subjective and highly competitive.

Tuition students will be considered based on a set of criteria. Criteria includes, but not limited to:

- Space availability per grade level
- Academic performance data (grades, assessment scores) and tuition exam score
- Attendance data
- Disciplinary data
- Payment of tuition.

In some cases, a decision to accept a tuition student cannot be made until mid summer, especially for elementary students.

Tuition applications will be accepted at the **elementary school for <u>Kindergarten</u> and <u>6th grade</u> only for the 2022-2023 school year. The high school is accepting applications for all grade levels (7-12)** for the 2022-2023 school year. Applications must be accompanied with the required items listed below:

- Academic performance data (grades, assessment data such as STAR/MAP/PSAT/Stanford /KPREP/ACT/IOWA Skills) are REQUIRED if the student has taken them.
- A letter of interest stating why you want your child to attend Beechwood and describe any extracurricular activities.
- Attendance data
- Disciplinary data
- Any other supporting materials that may be relevant to the application
- \$25 application fee

A tuition exam is administered to all applicants. The testing dates are scheduled for Tuesday, *March 22, 2022* and Thursday, *June 2, 2022*. The <u>high school only</u> will be offering an additional test on July 27, 2022. The time is TDB. Once accepted, a \$500.00 non-refundable deposit is required to hold the student's space. Tuition rates for 2022-2023 are as follows:

ADA is the Average Daily Attendance amount that home school districts will release to us. If your home school district does not release the ADA or you live out of state, then you will pay the higher tuition amount. Most school districts do release the ADA.

Non-resident tuition students, if accepted, are admitted for one (1) school year only. At the end of the school year, the performance of the student, academically and behaviorally, will be evaluated to determine continued enrollment. If at any time during the school year a space availability problem, academic problem(s) or behavior problem(s) develops, or tuition is not paid as agreed upon in a timely manner, the non-resident tuition student may have his/her enrollment terminated. Athletic eligibility is determined by the KHSAA.
