- a. Expenses Discussed District money in the total and the allocation (ADA) money that comes from the state, the money has been reduced due to state budget. Budget forms are located on the google drive. Money that is not used on programs goes into the rotating items that need to be replaced, Smartboards etc...)
- b. Elementary Ledger account does carry a small balance, that is due to athletics (uniforms, equipment). Activity money is for basically things that occur outside of the school day. Mr. Ashley asked Volleyball to reduce their fee, they have been able to carry a balance over the past few years, have not arrived at a concrete number but will in the next few weeks.
