Founded in 1860, Beechwood High School is a public, independent school district. Beechwood Schools serves 1500 students Pre-K through high school. Both the Elementary School and High School have been awarded National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence status. **There are 122 students in the Class of 2026.**

ACCREDITATION & MEMBERSHIPS

Beechwood is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) and maintains membership in the National Association for College Admission Counseling (NACAC), the Kentucky Association for College Admission Counseling (KYACAC), and the College Board.

ACADEMIC CALENDAR AND COURSE LOAD

Beechwood operates on a seven period day. Most students take six courses per year. GPAs are only calculated in June each year. Semester grades are available for mid-year reports.

COLLEGE ENTRANCE TESTING

In Kentucky, all students are required to take the ACT. Beechwood Class of 2026 Average ACT Score: 23.60.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE

Beechwood calculates yearly GPAs on a 4.0 point scale. Grades in AP classes are weighted on a 5.0 scale. **Beechwood does not rank.** The highest grade at Beechwood is A, but as a result of weighting for AP classes, some students earn a final cumulative GPA higher than 4.0.
